PIOUS PERUSALS

All Saints is one of the major festivals of the Christian year. In the Roman Church it is a holy day of obligation. But it wasn’t so regarded until sometime after the Church began to develop sacramentaries. In fact, sometime between 607 and 610 it began with a festival of St. Mary and All Martyrs, first celebrated on May 13 at the Parthenon in Rome, which had been closed since the early six hundreds. Pope Gregory III changed name of the feast to All Saints, and the date of the observation to Nov. 1, and that date was kept in England. It is kept as a commemoration of all the faithful departed. All Souls day (Nov.2) originated in 998 at Cluny upon the instigation of St. Odilo, and was commemorative of all the departed.

In our prayer book, there is no set of propers for All Souls; but the Anglican Missal do have such propers, and it is celebrated in many places throughout Christendom on that date.
